- > Charitable Status.
 - You can also register as a Charity, under some circumstances.
 - o Rules are quite strict.
 - o There are some additional tax and grant benefits.
- ➤ Is your club CASC registered?
 - What is CASC? Community Amateur Sports Club, a status recognised by HM Customs and Excise (The Tax Man!)
 - Gift Aid
 - Rates relief
 - Income tax relief
 - o Requires an 'up to date' constitution!
- ➤ VAT. Is your club registered?
 - Most are not, now
 - Complicated and onerous.
- > Insurance.
 - o Your Insurance Policies may well be your clubs biggest single overhead expenditure.
 - Are you confident about your insurance policies, do they work for you?
 - o Do you use a Broker? Are you happy with the service he provides?
 - o How are your boats insured?
 - Individually.
 - As a fleet.
 - As part of the general 'contents'
 - Trailer Towing
 - Do you know what conditions and regulations there are about towing trailers, insurance and Road Traffic Act?
 - Does your policy include an 'Average' clause? Do you know what this means?
 - O Does your policy include 'Officer' protection?
 - o Are you complying with all the conditions?
 - Do you know what the conditions are!

Bye Laws

- Does you club include its rules and regulations in its constitution or with separate Bye Laws?
- O How are codes of conduct established?
- o Where is your Disciplinary and Disputes procedure written down?
- o Is your Welfare Policy up to date?
- o Have you considered GDPR?
